

In this collection of four short stories, Abubakar Gimba paints a clear picture of human nature in its varied propensities for love, lust, greed, betrayal, hypocrisy, and vengeance. The collection illustrates how cracks at the private level lead to chaos and degeneration at the public level. The work is a sad but insightful commentary on the insensitivity of government to the plight of her citizens, the deplorable states of the health and educational sectors, and the moral bankruptcy of those saddled with leadership.

As has become usual with Gimba, suspense, intrigue and freeflowing prose mark our this work.
